Highlights of Activity

Summary of the project and the proposed cooperation details

“SIPL” is the student program containing three sessions including workshops, social project competition and the mentorship scheme, with the aim of training students’ critical thinking ability targeted at both higher and lower form students. Senior form students compete on the topic of helping out the disables while junior form put concern over the care fund. The mentorship scheme is prepared for the winning teams of the two form competitions, which is proposed to last for two months, from mid-August to mid-September. The mentorship scheme is under process now. Further scheduling is still under arrangement.

Throughout the whole project planning and design, HKSAROSU neither involve in the workshop design, nor the preparation of the social project competition. According to the fifth cooperation proposal sent by the TKTOSU External Vice President Betsy LUI, HKSAROSU only needs to take up the job of inviting 3 judges (2 for junior form, 1 for senior form) for the social project competition final, and 4 mentors for the mentorship scheme. The President of HKSAROSU is one of the judges for the junior form competition. Moreover, the venue is originally to be booked by HKSAROSU as well. A working meeting will be scheduled before the meeting

Role of OSU

Apart from the original proposal, the actual cooperation is carried out in the following ways -

1) The invitation of judges

Professors were invited to be the judges for junior / senior form competition in the final competition dated 14th July, 2011.

Invitation letter have been sent to different social science professor in the social work and sociology discipline from the University of Hong Kong and the Chinese University of Hong Kong. However, replies were not flavourable. After long discussion with TKTOSU over

phone, it is compromised that TKTOSU will try to invite the professors that they know to be the judges of the event and the event was settled as last.

Our president had also fulfilled the commitment to be the judge in the junior form competition. Please refer to the part of “**Report from the President concerning the arrangement and details of the competition final**” for further details.

2) Offering help in the competition final

Not stated in the cooperation proposal, TKTOSU asked for some helpers to assist the operation of the event during the final competition. One helper, Yammy 11 had volunteered to help in the afternoon event.

3) The invitation of mentors

Invitation letter had been sent to 4 honorary advisor of HKSAROSU to be the mentors of the scheme, including Prof JY SUNG, Mr WONG Ying-wai, Dr LEUNG Wing-tai and Prof TSUI Lap-chee. Finally Prof SUNG and Dr LEUNG have promised to be the mentors of the programme. The scheduling of the mentorship scheme and the contact with the mentors are still in process. It is probably that the scheme will formally kick off in mid to late August.

Concerning the venue booking, as TKTOSU can book the venue free of charge, it is compromised that TKTOSU booked the venue.

Recommendations

Throughout the preparation and the execution of the SILP, Annis AU 09 is the contact person representing HKSAROSU. As the possibility for HKSAROSU being invited to be the co-organizer of similar activity is quite high, it is recommended that the 19th committee should take the following into consideration in cooperation -

1) Late scheduling and arrangement of TKTOSU

Throughout the cooperation in these months, TKTOSU could only confirm the date and venue of final competition 3 weeks before the final. The details of the mentorship scheme cannot be confirmed under now. Intensive follow-up job has to be done to make sure everything is on schedule.

2) The possible time clash between Young Leaders Congress, Outstanding Students Selection and Orientation Series

For the SIPL held this year, the duration of the project (from preparation to the execution) is the same of that of YLC and OSS, as well as the O-camp.
