Programme Overview

Due to lack of available land supply and suboptimal town planning in the past decades, there is notable space usage problem in Hong Kong, be it housing issues or public space controversies. By participating in Hong Kong Future Pioneers 2019, participants would be exposed to a holistic analysis of space related issues in Hong Kong. While the programme is focused on the area of public space such as its status quo and future directions, innovative ideas such as shared economy in space utilization would also be covered.
